## Course Itinerary

*This is a flexible trip itinerary that shows the general progression of the trip. Our exact schedule will depend highly on the weather, strength of the group, and time of year.*

**Day 0:** Pre-trip meeting at 6:00 PM (unless otherwise noted) at the IWLS office in Haines. After a brief meet and greet with your instructors and fellow students, we will discuss the course and students' goals and expectations. Bring your personal gear and clothing with you for a gear check this evening.

**Day 1:** We will travel to Skagway, Alaska organize all of our group and personal gear, and head to the cliffs for an introduction to rock climbing skills.

**Days 2–5:** We will cover a wide spectrum of rock-climbing skills including but not limited to: top-rope site selection, belaying, rock climbing technique (face/crack/etc...), rock assessment, and rock anchors

**Day 6-11:** Rock climbing. We will cover a wide spectrum of rock-climbing skills including but not limited to rock climbing technique (face/crack/etc...), rock anchors, belaying, top-roping, mock leading
